- How do I access my certificate after completing a course?

Step 1: Upon completion of a course, you will be able to access and view your certificate. On the Credit page, click on “Access your Transcript.” It will take you to the MyCME portal.

Alternatively, visit <https://cmeapps.facs.org/cme/> to log in to MyCME. Use MyCME to manage your CME credit at your convenience. With MyCME, you can view, upload, and track CME activities; electronically share CME Credits; and reflect on and plan your future learning.

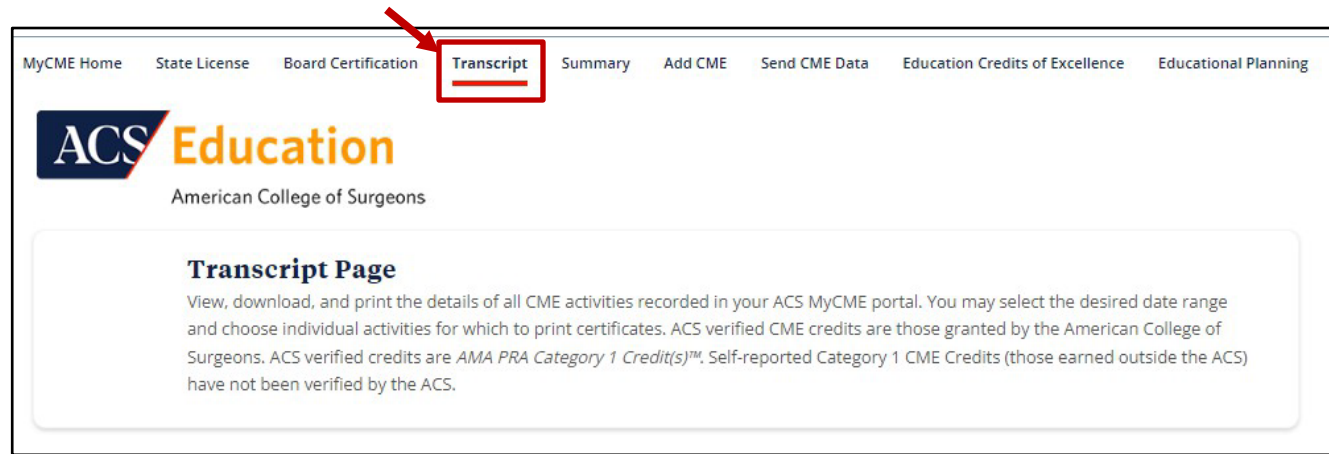

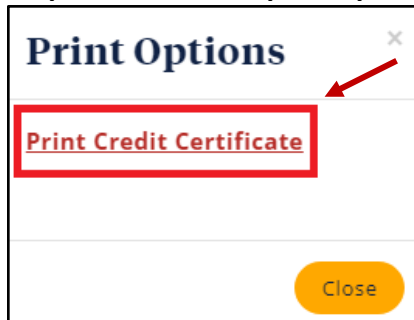
Step 2: Click on the “Transcript” tab at the top of the page, the certificates will be listed for the courses you completed.
