

- How do I access my certificate after I complete a course in the ACS Online Learning Portal?

**Step 1: Upon completion of a course in the ACS Online Learning Portal, you will be able to access and view your certificate. On the Credit page, click on “Access your Transcript.”** It will take you to the MyCME portal.

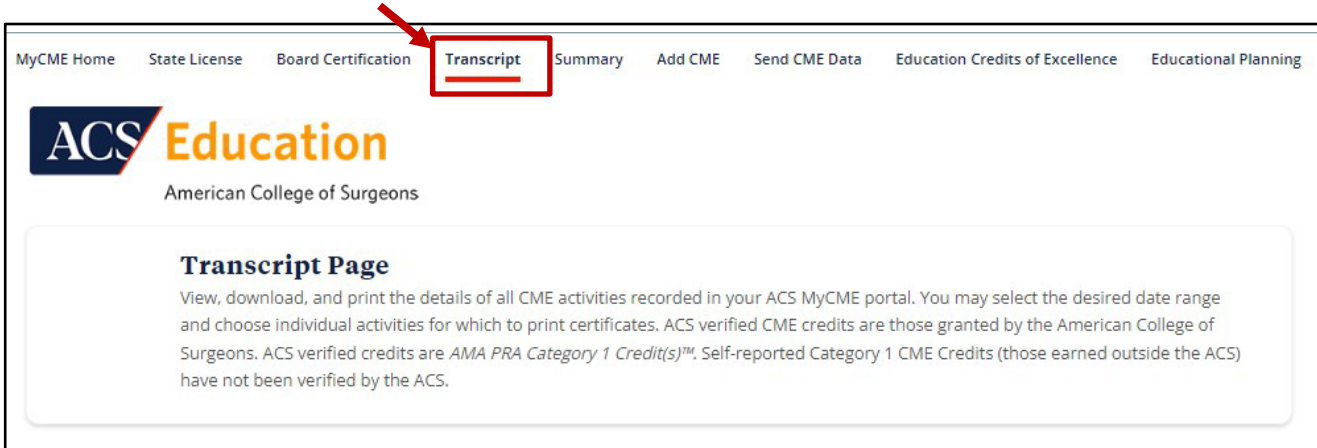

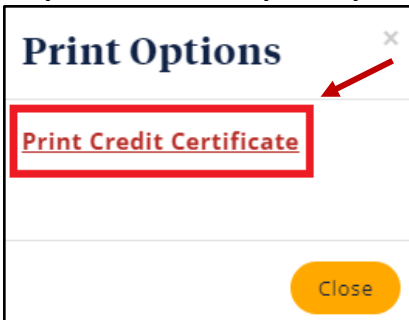
**Step 2: Click on the “Transcript” tab at the top of the page, the certificates will be listed for the courses you completed.**
