


I already enrolled in/purchased a course; how do I access my online course?

If you already enrolled in/ purchased an online course, you will receive an order confirmation email with instructions on how to access your course. Make sure to check your spam and junk folders.

Step 1: Go to your inbox and open the email, as an example below, it should contain the information for the product/course and your username. Click on “login and access your course”.

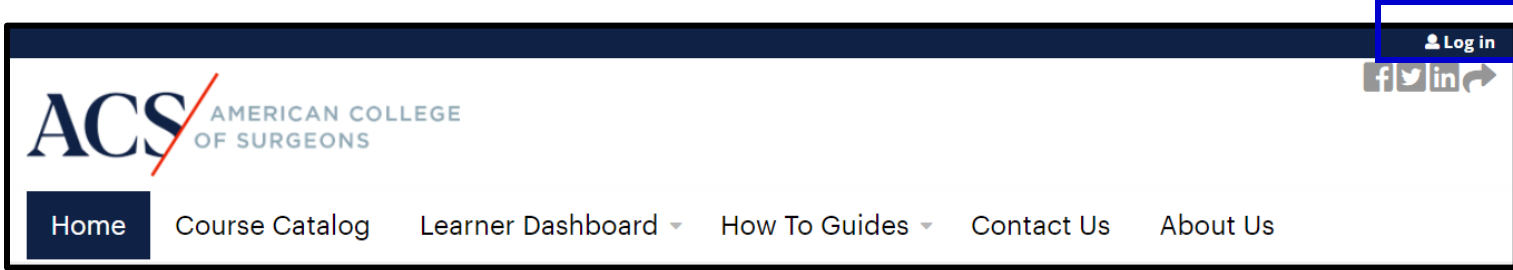

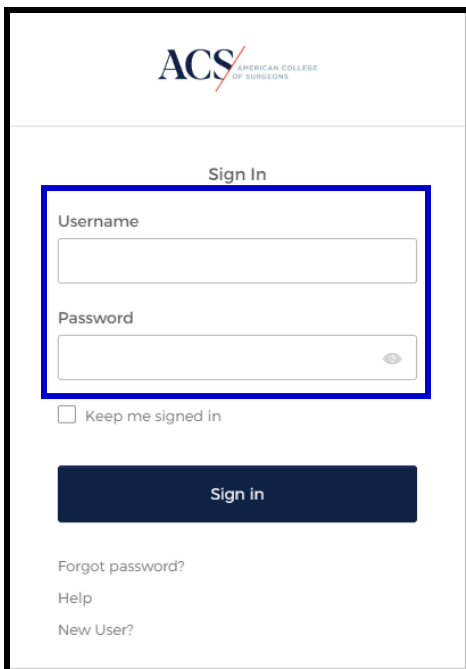



Step 2: Enter your username and password.




