If you already enrolled in/ purchased an online course, you will receive an order confirmation email with instructions on how to access your course. Make sure to check your spam and junk folders.

Step 1: Go to your inbox and open the email, as an example below, it should contain the information for the product/course and your username. Click on "login and access your course", which will go directly to <u>learning.facs.org</u>



If you cannot find the email, you may also go directly to <u>learning.facs.org</u> and click on "Log in" at the top righthand corner.



Step 2: Enter your username and password. If you forgot your password, please click on the "forgot password?" to receive an email to reset the password.
